Bill	Description
A06572 WARM UP BILL	An act to create a temporary state commission to examine and assess the use of excessive force by law enforcement in the state of New York, to make recommendations relative to the alleviation thereof; to amend the county law, in relation to providing for the appointment of a special prosecutor to investigate and prosecute charges of police misconduct and brutality .
A00339	This bill seeks to address the problems encountered when federal immigration enforcement intersects with the child welfare system. The New York State Reuniting Families Act prioritizes keeping children with their families and out of the public welfare system whenever possible and ensures that separated families receive appropriate care and due process.
A00253	Relates to traffic stops conducted by law enforcement officers; defines "racial profiling"; authorizes division of criminal justice services to conduct a study relating to racial profiling; prohibits use of race or ethnicity of an individual as the sole factor in determining the existence of probable cause to place such person under arrest or take into custody.
A00728	An act to amend the education law, in relation to the exclusion of illegal aliens from attending public post-secondary educational institutions.
