Bill	Description
A06572 WARM UP BILL	An act to create a temporary state commission to examine and assess the use of excessive force by law enforcement in the state of New York, to make recommendations relative to the alleviation thereof; to amend the county law, in relation to providing for the appointment of a special prosecutor to investigate and prosecute charges of police misconduct and brutality.
S00471B	AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to creating the New York DREAM fund commission; eligibility requirements and conditions governing general awards, academic performance awards and student loans; eligibility requirements for assistance under the higher education opportunity programs and the collegiate science and technology entry program; financial aid opportunities for students of the state university of New York, the city university of New York and community colleges;
A07430	The purpose of this bill is to establish New York as a "sanctuary state" by creating a clear distinction between the New York law enforcement and federal immigration enforcement to protect the safety and well-being of New York's immigrant community.
A2040	In order to achieve fair pay for all, policymakers must enact laws that prevent wage discrimination. This bill would make it unlawful to ask prospective employees for wage or salary history as a requirement for a job interview, job application, job offer, or promotion.
