

## FACT SHEET

### OVERVIEW:

- Late Assemblyman Angelo Del Toro, in collaboration with the NYS Office of Bilingual Education and World Languages (OBEWL), created the Institute for high school students of Puerto Rican/Hispanic descent.
- The *Angelo Del Toro Puerto Rican/Hispanic Youth Leadership Institute* is a collaboration with the NYS Assembly & Senate Puerto Rican/Hispanic Task Force in conjunction with the annual SOMOS conference, Office of Bilingual Education and World Languages, and the New York City Public Schools.
- The Angelo Del Toro takes place every year during the SOMOS conference in Albany.
- The program has been in existence for 35 years.

### GOALS OF THE INSTITUTE – STUDENTS WILL:

- Gain an understanding of the NYS legislative process by participating in research and the development of legislative proposals.
- Develop leadership skills.
- Gain an understanding of responsible citizenship.
- Create opportunities for interaction with positive role models such as elected officials and other adult professionals.
- Promote a dialogue between youth and community leaders concerning issues that affect Hispanic youth and their communities.

### PROGRAM PHASES OF PR/HYLI:

- **Phase 1:** Regional Delegation Study of Topics
- **Phase 2:** Participation in the Three-Day Institute
- **Phase 3:** Extension and Refinement of Leadership Skills
- **Phase 4:** Outstanding Student Delegate Educational Trips

### SINCE THE INCEPTION OF THE INSTITUTE:

- Approximately 8,000 students of Hispanic descent have participated in the Institute, with additional students participating in regional delegation trainings.
- In partnership with SOMOS, high school seniors entering colleges/universities have received more than a half million dollars in postsecondary scholarships.

### SCHOLARSHIPS:

- 1991-2012 SOMOS awarded 20 scholarships of \$500 annually, with an overall total of **\$210,000**.
- 2013 SOMOS awarded 30 scholarships ranging from \$500 - \$1,000 each, totaling **\$20,000**.
- 2014 SOMOS awarded 38 scholarships ranging from \$750 - \$1,500 each, totaling **\$36,000**.
- 2015 SOMOS awarded 37 scholarships ranging from \$640 - \$2,500 each, totaling **\$37,960**.
- 2016 SOMOS awarded 33 scholarships ranging from \$720 - \$3,000 each, totaling **\$40,000**.
- 2017 SOMOS awarded 31 scholarships ranging from \$1,000 - \$3,000 each, totaling **\$40,000**.
- 2018 SOMOS awarded 39 scholarships ranging from \$550 - \$3,000 each, totaling **\$43,000**.
- 2019 SOMOS awarded 30 scholarships ranging from \$800 - \$3,000 each, totaling **\$40,000**.
- 2020 SOMOS awarded 37 scholarships ranging from \$770 - \$3,080 each, totaling **\$50,000**.
- 2021 SOMOS awarded 20 scholarships, each equaling \$500 per winner, totaling **\$10,000**.
- 2022 SOMOS awarded 30 scholarships ranging from \$500 - \$3,200 each, totaling **\$50,000**.
- 2023 SOMOS awarded 35 scholarships ranging from \$500 - \$3,200 each, totaling **\$50,000**.
- 2024 SOMOS awarded 35 scholarships ranging from \$500 - \$3,400 each, totaling **\$50,000**.
- 2025 SOMOS awarded 43 scholarships ranging from \$1,000-\$2,750 each, totaling **\$75,000**.
